Last chance to have your say on pay

Time is running out for you to have your say on pay in UNISON's ballot on the government's pay proposals.

The ballot closes at **10am on 2 March** so if you haven't returned your ballot paper you need to get it in the post as soon as possible.

The action taken by ambulance members was a key factor in the government sitting down and negotiating the current proposals, including the additional concessions for ambulance staff.
