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Earlier today, all Staff Side Representatives within WMAS, who recently attended HUB meetings, were called to a meeting with Senior Managers to discuss the information cascaded to staff at these meetings regarding the industrial action on due to take place on Monday 13th October.

They had been informed by their management team that staff had been bullied and harassed by Union Reps into taking part in the walk out on Monday and that the information cascaded to them at these meetings had not been what was agreed.

Any staff taking part in the industrial action have the right to walk out between the hours of 07.00-11.00 on Monday 13th October or work to the exceptions requested by management of Red 1s, Red 2s and upgraded Green calls.

All staff have the right to make an informed choice based on the information given to them and the options offered.

Under no circumstances should any member of staff have been harassed or bullied into taking part in the strike action on Monday 13th October and if this did happen, as reported by management, at any of the HUB meetings please contact another Senior Union Representative or either of the emails above.
